The children's classes are as follows: Nagabhushanam is studying 7<sup>th</sup> grade; Naveena is studying 6<sup>th</sup> grade; Raju is studying 5<sup>th</sup> grade; Daniel is studying 4<sup>th</sup> grade; Daveedu is studying 4<sup>th</sup> grade; Ramani is studying 3<sup>rd</sup> grade; Tabitha is studying 3<sup>rd</sup> grade; Satish is studying 3<sup>rd</sup> grade; Paul is studying 2<sup>nd</sup> grade; Remaining two had gone home in the last week of May and did not come back. I am in the process of admitting 5 new children. I have few applications. It will be cleared with in a week.

Everyone is enjoying the Christian atmosphere. They were being trained regularly to get up early, study the Bible, pray, learn a Bible verse each day. Before going the bed every one will have a combined devotion. They are enjoying the good food and the better home.
