Dear Friends,

*Greetings. The schools are back in session. Every one has graduated to the next class. We bought new schoolbooks for each student and purchased new school clothes for them as well. We are in the process of buying new school bags. More books and more studies. Please pray for these children so that they will study harder in their new class and get good grades. Here the monsoon season arrived late. The after affects of change of seasons has been viral fevers, which includes chicken dengue. (caused by mosquitoes bites.)Many people in our city and throughout our state are suffering with this. All the hospitals are filled with patients with these diseases. Pray that our children will not get these fevers due to exposure to other students in the classrooms. The number of children has risen to 25. Three more are expected within a couple of days. As of now we have 3 children in the 7th grade, 4 children in the 6th grade, 4 children in the 5th grade, one child in the 4th grade, and 8 children in the 3rd grade, 3 children in the 2nd grade and 2 children in the 1st grade. Pray that this year also will a fruitful year for the children. Pray that they will grow both physically and spiritually. On behalf of our children I once again thank you. May the Lord bless you.*
