Our children at Hope children home are growing every day. At present we have 9 children and the grades they are going to as follows: Mr. Nagabhushanam is studying 7th grade, Ms. Naveena is studying 6th grade, Mr. Raju is studying 5th grade, Mr. Daveedu is studying 4th grade, Mr. Daniel is studying 4th grade, Mr. Satish is studying 3rd grade, Ms. Ramya is studying 3rd grade, Ms. Tabita is studying 3rd grade, and Mr. Paul is studying 2nd grade. After coming to the home everyone's education has been improved drastically. They are able to read better, write better, and to score good scores in the test above the rest in the class. Every evening for two hours after they had refreshments the tutor will sit with them and make them study the home work and class work. Even the Christian activity is also been increased in their lives. Every morning they have a prayer meeting. Every day before they take the breakfast they have to memorize a verse from the Bible. And every evening before going to bed they have another prayer meeting. By the grace of God every child is growing both physically, mentally and also spiritually. Pray that every one will come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ. Last month some of our children participated in school game competitions.
