Greetings. The children are happy to finish another year of their school. Last month they were free without any school work and were happy to spend it as they wanted to. They did spend their time to go to beach and other parks in Vizag. They also had the privilege to attend Vacation Bible School and we have another beach visit planned for them.

This summer the mercury has touched 105°C in Vizag, but in other parts of our state it has reached 110°C. Now the monsoon is very active and we have received lot of rain. Due to the heavy rain most of our dams are full of water and flooding has taken place in many areas. The weather man is predicting that the monsoon will be even more active during the days to come.

The children are now busy with their new classes and with new books. Our children are now in the following classes: 3 in 8th grade, 4 in 7th grade, 4 in the 6th grade, one in 5th grade, 6 in 4th grade, 5 in 3rd grade and 3 in 2nd grade. We have one new child from 150 km north of Vizag. He is studying 7th.
